PATTERN FOR MICE

MATERIALS

MUST BE DOUBLE KNIT WOOL, ANYTHING THINNER WILL BE TORN APART TOO EASILY, ANYTHING THICKER BECOMES TOO STIFF

NO: 11 (3MM) NEEDLES, STANDARD KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS USED

TENSION

NEEDS TO BE FAIRLY TIGHT OR ELSE IT CAN BE TORN APART TOO EASILY

TO MAKE BODY

CAST ON 10 STITCHES FOR TAIL END AND SS 2 ROWS

NEXT INC ROW: INC INTO EACH STITCH – 20STS P 1 ROW

NEXT INC ROW: (K1 INC) TO END – 30STS SS 3 ROWS

NEXT INC ROW: (KN2 INC) TO END – 40STS SS 11 ROWS

NEXT DEC ROW: (K2, K2 TOG) TO END – 30STS SS 9 ROWS

NEXT DEC ROW: (K1, K2 TOG) TO END – 20STS SS 7 ROWS

NEXT DEC ROW: (K2 TOG) TO END – 10STS SS 5 ROWS

BREAK YEARN, LEAVING A LONG END, THREAD THROUGH STS AND DRAW UP

TO MAKE EARS (MAKE 2 PIECES)

CAST ON 18 STS AND SS 2 ROWS

NEXT DEC ROW: (K2 TOG) TO END – 9STS

BREAK YEARN, LEAVING A LONG END, THREAD THROUGH STS AND DRAW UP

PLEASE LEAVE LONG ENDS OF WOOL AT BOTH BEGINNING AND END OF KNITTING TO ENABLE THE MICE TO BE MADE UP. WRAP EARS INSIDE BODY

THESE CURRENTLY SELL AT £1 EACH AND HAVE PROVED VERY POPULAR, SO A SUPPLY THROUGHOUT THE YEAR IS NEEDED.
