

The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre has a minimum donation policy

Any cat over the age of 6 months adopted from the centre will have been neutered and had at least its first vaccination for flu and enteritis. The cat is covered by Pet plan Veterinary insurance for up to 6 weeks.

A minimum donation of £35 is requested for the cat. This does not cover the full cost, so any further donation is very much appreciated.

Any kitten under the age of 6 months will have had at least its first vaccination for flu and enteritis and will be covered by Petplan veterinary insurance for up to 6 weeks.

All kittens must be neutered at 6 months of age. **All neutering of kittens adopted from The CRRC are neutered on site by a qualified vet, and you will be asked to bring the kitten in at the appropriate time. There will be NO exceptions to this rule** You will be asked to pay £40 for either male or female kitten, which is payable WHEN you adopt the kitten, and will cover the total neutering cost.

Additionally a minimum donation of £20 is requested for the kitten. This does not cover the full cost, so any further donation is very much appreciated..

The CRRC insist on all domestic cats to leave The Centre with a collar and id on, and must be transported in a proper carrier (cardboard or corrugated plastic is not permitted). These products are for sale on site (new and secondhand).

All rabbits will have been vaccinated for myxomatosis + free Petplan veterinary insurance for up to 6 weeks.

If the rabbit is neutered/spayed the minimum donation will be £35

If the rabbit is not neutered the minimum donation will be £35 , and you will be given a neutering voucher & you will be required to bring the rabbit back to the Centre for neutering at the appropriate time. (as above in the kitten section) (Not to be used for breeding)

Guinea pig minimum donation will be £10 (Not to be used for breeding)

You can also have your cat or rabbit microchipped at The Centre for £12.50

Cash or cheques (with up to date bankers cheque card) only.

NO credit cards/switch etc.

To take on a pet and use other charities for BASIC veterinary is totally selfish, and uncharitable.

Male cat neuter between £33 - £74

Female cat spay between £45 - £82

1st vac (for flu and enteritis) between £20 - £29 only 1 vac reqd yearly after initial 2

2nd vac (for flu and enteritis) between £20 - £29

Male rabbit neuter between £38 - £69

Female rabbit spay between £43 - £103

Rabbit myxi vac between £19 - £30 (required every 6 months)

Rabbit V H D vac between £20 - £30
